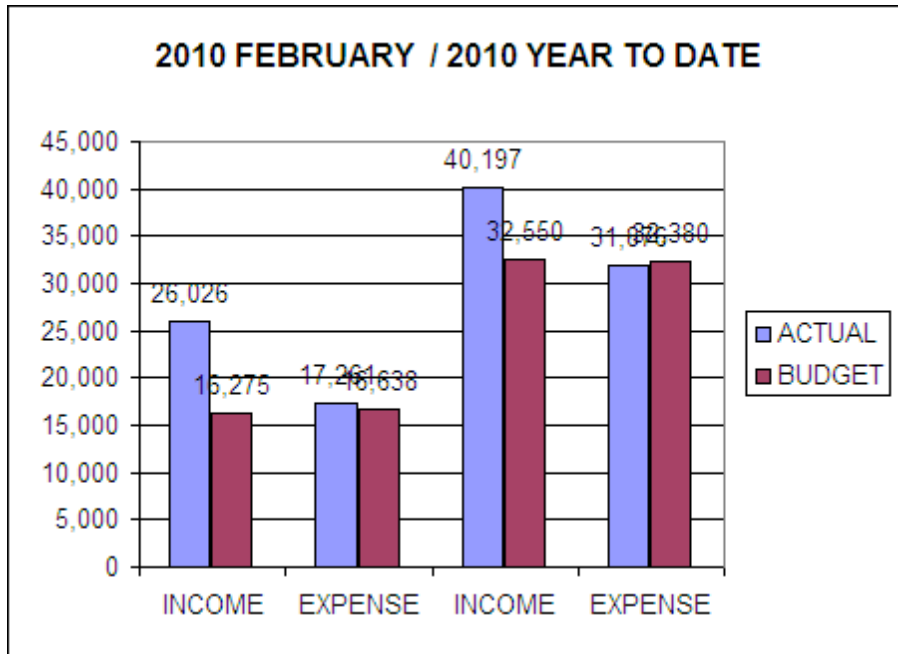
Next Directory Updates are due in the office by March 14th. If you will need a new picture taken, Tammy will have the camera in church on February 28th & March 7th.
